David Edwards-May, former president of Inland Waterways International, is an international consultant and expert on inland waterways and their multiple functions. He has conducted consulting assignments on inland waterways since 1985, initially as a project manager in SOGREAH Consulting Engineers, then as an independent consultant. Author of nearly 100 studies and expert appraisals on the economic value and feasibility of waterways, funding, operation, management and development, he has also established a worldwide reputation as publisher of high-quality planning maps and works of reference. He has chaired three PIANC Working Groups on inland waterways development focused on both tourism and inland water transport. He has recently been providing services to the company building the new Seine-Nord Europe Canal in northern France. He is editor of IWI's magazine World Wide Waterways.
