Reconstruction and Development), Busan Port Authority, KOICA (Korea International Cooperation Agency) and the Korea Ministry of Ocean and Fisheries.

Prior to joining the University of Malta, he has been a lecturer and Assistant Professor since 2017 and was responsible for ICS Korea Exam Centre and lecturer in shipping business.
