Short Bio

Dr. S. June KIM is an associate professor of Korea Maritime and Ocean University and master mariner. After onboarding merchant marine for 3 years, he studied history at Korea University in Seoul from 1993 to 2002 in which he got a doctorate on *English shipping industry during the industrial revolution*. He worked at maritime museum in Korea Maritime University from 2002 to 2007, at Korea Branch School of Netherlands Shipping and Transport College from 2007 to 2009, at Mokpo Maritime University in 2012 and finally joined KMOU in October, 2017. He is interested in a history of English shipping, a history of navigation and a maritime history.

Dr. S. June KIM has 20 authored books including *The Age of European Exploration*(2019) and *Origin of Maritime English*(2015), 8 Korean translation books including *A Short History of the World's Shipping Industry* by Ernest Fayle and published 57 researched papers including Government Policy and the Rise of a national Shipping Industry : Korea's Experience 1967-1999 in *International Journal of Maritime History*(Vol.31.2, 2019).

Dr. S. June KIM was awarded Chojeong Academic Prize(The Best Paper Award) by Korean Association and Maeil Newspaper and Global Group in 2010, The KR Prize by KASL and Korean Register of Shipping in 2012 and registered in Marquis Who's Who in 2018-2019.

He was a member of advisory group for Ministry of Maritime Affairs and Fisheries from 2013 to 2016 and is a member of advisory Group for Ministry of Oceans and Fisheries from 2019 to Present.
