Andrej Lisec is associate professor in the logistics, reverse logistics and sustainability fields and a researcher. He has been involved in the coordination and implementation of several international and national projects, focusing on sustainability, reduction of logistics cost and environment. He was member of the expert group by the European commission in the field Smart, green and integrated transport for the H2020 in the Member States, he is in the Expert group for the Strategic Transport Research and Innovation Agenda (STRIA) governance.

He has many international experiences and have been studying and working at the institutions outside Slovenia, an invited lecturer at the Zagreb University in Croatia, and University of Cartagena, Spain; he was studying at University of Viadrina, Germany. During his projects work he has been collaborating with various international partners, including academia and companies. Recently, he was involved in the preparation of the biggest logistics conference in the world, where more than 120 researchers and professors were involved. He closely collaborated with the Conference on Transport and Research in the Danube Region.

Until now, he has published more than 400 bibliographic units, including papers, conference proceedings, and chapters in monographs.
