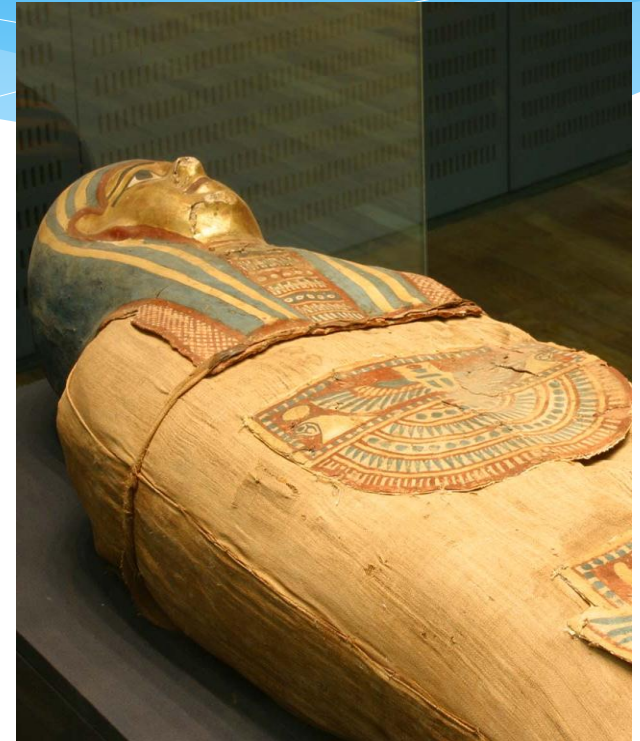


Alexandria Port & Port Museum



Alexandria Port is one of the oldest ports in the world. Which takes precedence over Egypt ports with regards to the volume of trade traffic, where about 60% of Egypt foreign trade is handled through it.

The National Museum

* **Four museums:** (The Antiquities Museum –The Manuscripts Museum – The Sadat Museum – The History of Science Museum – The Planetarium Science Center (PSC))

Started in 2001, The Museum contain many pieces rare manuscripts and books, from pharaohs period to the modern period. moreover, **The MsM** provides the largest possible number of digital manuscripts from all over the world.



The Great Library of Alexandria Antiquities Museum



The Museum was officially inaugurated on 16 October 2002. Its collections were carefully selected to reflect the rich, multi-cultural history of Egypt with its Pharaonic, Greco-Roman, Coptic, and Islamic heritage. Special focus is given to Alexandria and the Hellenistic period. The Museum houses **1,133** pieces, which unique collections.
