### “Towards a Sustainable Blue Economy”



**Dr. Hydouk Kim**

**Dean, College of Future Convergence, Suncheon National University, the Republic of Korea.**

Dr. Kim initially graduated from the Korea Maritime and Ocean University with a bachelor’s degree and a master’s degree from the department of shipping management. In 2003, Dr. Kim earned a Doctor of Philosophy in maritime transport at the Arab Academy for Science and Technology and Maritime Transport.

Since 2006, Dr. Kim has excelled as a professor at Suncheon National University, where he teaches a full course load in addition to pursuing research work in his specialty. He has published more than 60 articles in a variety of international journals, and has presented more than 30 papers at international shipping and maritime conferences, accepting awards as a result at the 2016 Trade Commerce Conference and the 2018 Port Economic Conference. Throughout his tenure with Suncheon National University, Dr. Kim has held a variety of administrative positions, including as the head of the Global Logistics Education Center and the Advanced Shipping and Port Logistics Education Center.

Dr. Kim was appointed as the dean of future convergence and the director of the Lifelong Education Center at Suncheon National University in 2018, and currently participates on the development council and chairman, the harbor committee for the Yeosu Gwangyang Port. His recent publications have included studies of the efficiency of container ports and port selection criteria in the Bay of Bengal published in the Journal of the Korean Port Economic Association, and a modeling of market factors in halal transportation for the International Journal of e-Navigation and Maritime Economy.

Dr. Kim is the author of several books which remain in print in updated editions, such as “Introduction to Shipping & Port Policy in Korea” in 2009, and the Korean-language versions of “Logistics-Related Law” in 2016, and “Logistics Business” in 2015.

Among other awards, Dr. Kim has been recognized among Suncheon National University’s Top Research Staff in 2016 and Top Teaching Staff in 2017 and 2018. Likewise, he is the recipient of a 2019 Land, Infrastructure, and Transport Minister’s Award. As one of the leading scholars in his specialty, Dr. Kim further flourishes as the president of the International Association of e-Navigation and Ocean Economy and the vice president of the Korea Port Economic Association and a member of the editorial boards for the Asian Journal of Shipping & Logistics, the Association of Navigation and Port Research and the Association of the Korean Society of Marine Environment.
